

**Rocky Mountain Masonic Conference
Memo of Understanding**

History:

The Rocky Mountain Masonic Conference (RMMC) was formed on February 22, 1952. Initially, it was comprised of the following Jurisdictions: Colorado, Montana, Utah and Wyoming. The first meeting of the RMMC was held in Casper, Wyoming on July 11-12, 1952.

Over the years the RMMC expanded its membership to add Arizona, Idaho, Nevada, New Mexico, and Nebraska.

The sitting Grand Master and Grand Secretary of the host jurisdiction serve as the President and Secretary of the Conference, the Vice President is the officer who will be Grand Master of the host jurisdiction the following year. The official delegates and voting members of the Conference are composed of the elective officers of the respective Grand Lodges. However, any Master Mason from the member jurisdiction or one that is in amity with the member jurisdictions is welcome to attend.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Rocky Mountain Masonic Conference (RMMC) is to provide a forum for the member jurisdictions to exchange matters of Masonic interest among our Rocky Mountain States, and to develop Masonic Education programs for our Lodges. The RMMC is an informal gathering that allows the presentation of information that is of a common concern or interest.

Summary:

Current Jurisdictions: Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Utah, Nevada, Arizona, Nebraska, New Mexico, Colorado

Rotation to Host the Conference is on a rotation that has been agreed on by the participating Grand jurisdictions

Location (City, Hotel) is chosen by the host Jurisdiction.

Traditionally meets on the 3rd Friday and Saturday in July

The sitting Grand Master and Grand Secretary of the host jurisdiction serve as the President and Secretary of the Conference, the Vice President is the officer who will be Grand Master of the host jurisdiction the following year.

Agenda Theme / topics for the conference are suggested by the host Jurisdiction and distributed to the member Jurisdiction by mid-February for presenters to choose and plan presentations.

Cost to host the Conference is collected by Registrations to the Conference. (Conferences should be self-funded.)

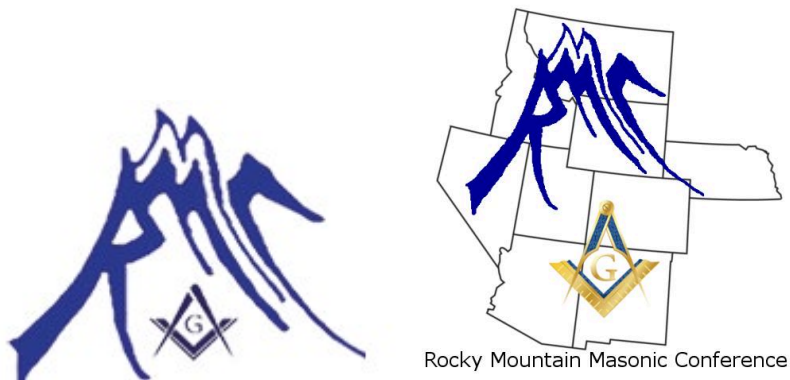
